Applications must be postmarked by February 29, 2019.

- 3. Benefitting from scholarship

The applications for this scholarship award <u>must include the following</u>:

- 1. Completed 2020 Local Scholarship Application High School
- 2. The required essay
- 3. A copy of your high school transcript

All applicant names, family names and addresses will be kept anonymous during the review and selection process by the Scholarship Committee. The selected scholarship recipients will be notified by Northbrook Woman's Club Foundation in late May.
